A. Since the last meeting the following applications have been considered.

1. Earlswood, Lower Road, Harmer Hill – erection of extension and alterations to dwelling. Application supported.
2. The Coppice, Shotton Lane, Harmer Hill – tree felling and pruning. No comment.
3. The Top Barn, Newton on the Hill – erection of 2 bay open fronted garage. Application supported.
4. Tan House, Marton – two storey side extension. Application supported.
5. Heatherdale, Webscott, Myddle – change of use of annexe building to residential unit. Support but suggest that windows should match the existing and stone plaque should be retained.
6. Orchard House, Wem Road, Harmer Hill – erection of dwelling and garage. Noted that planning had been refused twice before. Objected to on the grounds that the site is too cramped and the visibility splay in both directions is substandard for a 40mph restricted highway.
7. Smallwood- erection of single storey dwelling. Supported although Members would prefer the access in the original application.
