ACTION PLAN

The Council will:

1. Maintain strict control over expenditure to ensure that parishioners get value for their Council Tax payment.
2. Ensure that the Council continually works to develop and maintain the aims stated in the Council's Mission Statement.
3. Encourage members of the public to attend Council meetings and bring issues of concern or interest to the attention of Councillors.
4. Monitor and respond to all planning applications in line with those ideals stated in the Parish Plan and identify and attempt to meet the needs of those seeking affordable accommodation.
5. Continue to liaise with and put pressure on Shropshire Council with regard to road safety issues highlighted by residents and Councillors, which will include improved measures by Myddle School.
6. Ensure that the Children's Play Areas are maintained to a high safety standard.
7. Maintain strong links with the police to ensure that there is a continued low level of crime throughout the Parish.
8. Continue to seek improvements to highways maintenance including pot hole repairs.
9. Continue to monitor and up-date the Community Led Plan and respond to issues that arise at various times.
10. Take action to curb and remove litter deposits throughout the Parish.
11. Ensure that regular news items and relevant information is published on the web site, in the Messenger and where appropriate in the local press.
12. Encourage Members to attend relevant training opportunities.
13. Support the Clerk in the provision of a professional service.
